

Things to Bring List - Puerto Rico

Each participant may bring (1) CHECKED BAG and (1) CARRY-ON BAG. You may be asked to pack up to 5lbs of team supplies in your checked bag so leave space - only pack 45 lbs. Don't bring valuables you would be upset to lose.

Carry-On Bag (Small backpack or day pack)

- Travel documents (driver's license, state issued ID or passport)
- Vaccine card or negative Covid test and QR code from discoverpuertorico.com
- Spending money for snacks/souvenirs
- Bible, devotional book, pens
- Prescription or personal medication
- (1) travel sized hand sanitizer

Checked Bag (45lbs or less)

- (1) Church outfit
- (1) Adventure day outfit – Long shorts, t-shirt, swimsuit, and beach towel
*Girls swimsuits must be one-piece or have a dark-colored t-shirt over two-piece
- Undergarments and socks
- Sleepwear (shorts and t-shirt)
- (10) masks
- Casual outreach wear (no leggings)
- (3) Sets of work clothes (long pants and t-shirts that might get ruined/stained)
- (1) Pair of work gloves
- (2) Pairs of tennis/athletic shoes, comfy for walking, sturdy enough for work projects
- (1) Pair of flip-flops or shower shoes
- Clothes to wear around lodging complex (shorts, t-shirts, jeans)
- Sweatshirt/jacket
- Last names ending in A-G bring (1) Plastic bottle of peanut butter
- Last names ending in H-Z bring (1) squeeze jar of Jelly (grape/strawberry)
- Twin-sized sheets, light blanket, small travel pillow, washcloth, and a towel
- Toiletries (shampoo, soap, deodorant, toothpaste, toothbrush, contact solution, etc.)
- 32oz Water Bottle (Nalgene or similar brand, must be re-useable and shatterproof)
- Outdoor supplies (sunscreen, insect repellent, sunglasses/hat, rain poncho)
- Tools: hammer, screwdriver, pliers, safety glasses, paint scraper, and tool apron/belt
- Miscellaneous extras (alarm clock, flashlight, healthy snacks) – *Optional*
