The Country

A beautiful land of mountains, volcanoes and lakes with ancient colonial villages and Mayan ruins. Belonging to 60 different people groups, residents of Guatemala speak more than 42 distinct languages, but most people know Spanish because it is the country's official language. Our team will serve primarily in Guatemala City and nearby villages where many still wear their traditional tribal garb.

The Ministry

Friendly by nature, it's easy to meet people and initiate conversations in Guatemala. While many of the Guatemalans consider themselves Christians, a great number of them are only Christians in a cultural sense and do not have a personal relationship with Jesus. The people are open-minded, and both school and government officials welcome Christianity so the doors are wide open to share your faith. All it takes is a one-on-one conversation with a missionary like you to help Guatemalan students bridge the gap from religion to relationship. Be prepared for the Lord to use you to bring light into spiritual darkness!

This week will include:

- 1.5 days of community development projects
- 3 days of Gospel presentations in schools
- Encouraging local churches
- Enjoy an adventure day exploring local artisan markets, hiking an active volcano and more!

How to Go

- Check for your name on the GO List on October 5th
- If your name is on the GO List, submit all parts of Registration by October 17th

Registration (done by Oct 17)

- Notarize Liberty Waiver and turn in to Spiritual Life Office
- Notarize RIM Consent Form and turn in to Spiritual Life Office
- Submit online Registration Form
- Submit \$95 non-refundable deposit online

Trip Cost: \$2455

- **Trip cost includes** airfare and ground transportation, in-country meals, lodging, baggage fees, ministry training, teacher trip scholarship, international insurance, departure taxes, adventure day, and ministry supplies.
- **Trip cost does NOT include** passports, immunizations, airport meals and souvenirs.
- **Donations to RIM are tax-deductible.** All funds raised toward the Guatemala project are non-refundable and non-transferable.

- \$785 more by Nov 9th (\$880 or more total raised)
- \$785 more by Dec 9th (\$1665 or more total raised)
- \$790 more by Feb 9th (\$2,455/100% total raised)

Passport

- RIM requires that your passport must be valid SIX MONTHS AFTER the trip. If your passport expires before **9/17/2023**, you'll need to renew it as soon as possible.
- If you do not already have a Passport, please apply for one immediately.
- If you are not a US citizen, or your passport is from a country other than the United States, please make sure you have the needed travel documentation for entry into the host country and for reentry into the U.S.

Immunizations needed:

- Up-to-date childhood immunizations (required)*
- Up-to-date Tetanus (required - no exceptions)
- Hepatitis-A (required)*
- Typhoid (strongly recommended) *
