The Country

A beautiful country that is stable but faces many challenges. Widespread poverty, spreading urban slums and need for land reform create tension in Kenyan Society. There are 74 different languages spoken in Kenya and many of these ethnic groups clash over limited resources.

The Ministry

The team will be working in and around Kambiri with our One 2 One school partner. While there, they may be involved in sharing the Gospel through community development projects, tutoring students, food distribution and assisting teachers in schools. We will be working with the local missionaries to bring the hope of the Gospel to all!

Please note: Kenya requires a negative COVID-19 test for unvaccinated travelers to enter Kenya and Proof of Yellow Fever vaccination.

How to Go:

- On the Kenya page, submit online Application (includes medical info)
- Select your campus location and list your top 2 choices for your ministry location
- Submit \$95 non-refundable deposit due with Application

Trip Cost Information:

- **Trip cost includes** airfare from launch city, all ground transportation, on-location meals, lodging, leadership cost, ministry training, safari adventure, and ministry supplies.
- **Trip cost does not include** passport fees, souvenirs, baggage fees, vaccinations, international insurance, airport meals, and Kenya EVisa.
- **Donations to RIM are tax-deductible because RIM is a registered 501(c)3 organization.** All funds raised toward the project are non-refundable and non-transferable.

Fundraising Deadlines

- \$95 non-refundable deposit due with Application
- November 15: First Fundraising Deadline 1/3 of fundraising goal raised
- December 15: Second Fundraising Deadline 2/3 of fundraising goal raised
- February 15: Final Fundraising Deadline 100% raised

Covid Donation Protection plan

At RIM we commit to stewarding each donation with kingdom responsibility. We understand the challenges and questions that come from fundraising in the Covid era, so we have worked to implement this Covid Donation Protection plan that will allow for as much flexibility as possible.

- Trip cancellations or postponements qualify for transfer of all funds that have not been expended, toward another location that year or for a future RIM trip.
- If an individual is unable to participate due to COVID-19 related issues, they also qualify for this donation protection. The funds he or she has raised that have not been expended, can go towards a future project, if done 30 days prior to the trip.

Immunizations Needed:

- Up-to-date childhood immunizations (required)*
- Up-to-date Tetanus (required - no exceptions)
- Proof of Yellow Fever Vaccination (required - no exceptions, must bring with to country)
- Malaria medicine (required)*
- Typhoid (recommended)
